

MANAGING DIRECTOR OF STANDARD & POOR'S TO ADDRESS ASIA PACIFIC BUSINESS LEADERS ON FINANCIAL CRISIS

Honolulu, October 13, 1998 - Phillip S. Bates, Managing Director of Standard & Poor's, will be addressing a gathering of leading corporate executives from throughout the Asia Pacific, at a conference on the Asian financial crisis to be held on October 19th in Los Angeles.
