

## PHILIPPINE SECRETARY OF FINANCE TO ADDRESS ASIA PACIFIC BUSINESS LEADERS ON FINANCIAL CRISIS

**Honolulu, October 12 , 1998 -** His Excellency, Edgardo B. Espiritu, Secretary of Finance for the Philippines, will be addressing a gathering of leading corporate executives from throughout the Asia Pacific, at a conference on the Asian financial crisis to be held on October 19th in Los Angeles.

The conference, entitled "The Asian Financial Crisis: A Focus on Solutions", will bring together key leaders from business, government, and international institutions, to focus on solutions, and strategies to turn the situation around.
