

## MIRZAN MAHATHIR, PRESIDENT OF KONSORTIUM LOGISTIC BERHAD, TO SPEAK AT PBEC CONFERENCE IN TOKYO

Honolulu, March 12, 2001 - Mirzan Mahathir, Executive Chairman and President of Konsortium Logistic Berhad, Malaysia, will be addressing delegates at the 34th International General Meeting (IGM) of the Pacific Basin Economic Council (PBEC), which will take place April 8th - 10th in Tokyo, Japan. The annual conference brings together leading business executives, heads of government, and government ministers from throughout Asia, the Pacific, and the Americas.

Mirzan Mahathir will be speaking in a session entitled "Information Technology and Telecommunication in the New Economy."
